The Mayo Clinic/Arizona State University Innovation Fund is specifically targeting the development of products and/or process reengineering aimed at improving patient care, enhancing care or administrative process efficiencies and effectiveness, and realizing the potential for commercialization beyond our own organizations.

To be considered, projects must be proposed jointly by representatives from both organizations. An Innovation Steering Committee has been established, and there will be a rolling application process throughout the year until the initial \$100,000 is fully deployed.
